DIRECTIONS

From the east or the west: (Note: If you are coming from the east, GPS will take you all the way through downtown, easier with a trailer to go around)
*I-90 to US-2W (Exit 277B) *Turn R on Flint Rd *Turn R on W Trails Rd *L on N Old Trails Rd *R on W 7 Mile Rd *R on Riverside Park
*R into park.

CAMP

Ride camp is open Thursday through Monday. Camp is a large, flat area with plenty of room for large trailers. This is a dry camp. Horse water will be provided in camp and on trails. We will have porta-potties available. Dogs are welcome but must be kept on leash at all times. No fires. We will have bins for manure and for garbage. The Mt Spokane High School Equestrian Team will be cleaning up campsites for a suggested donation of \$20. Panel pens only will be allowed. No hot wire or rope pens. Some trees for highlining are available with proper hi-tie equipment.

TRAIL

There will be three loops that are all well marked with GPS as backup. You will get to enjoy some diverse trails giving you amazing views of Spokane. You will be riding along the river, climbing a bit, meandering through single track trails, and the double-track trails will provide the opportunity to move out. This is a more technical ride than some and less than others but there will be some rocky terrain so hoof protection is recommended. This is a multiuse trail so you may encounter hikers or bicyclists. All vet checks will be back at ride camp.

FEES

Camping fees: \$12/unit per night. Additional vehicles: \$10/per night.
Day use: Discover Pass required for hauling in and out, no pass required if you are paying for camping. You can purchase this online <https://store.discoverpass.wa.gov/> or at the kiosk at camp.
Annual pass: \$35 or a one-day pass is \$11.50.
50 miles – \$115; 30 miles – \$105; 15 miles Intro Ride (Saturday) – \$35; Prize Ride (Sunday) – \$35
Non AERC fee – \$15 (Must show current AERC card – No fee for Intro/Prize Ride riders)
